Program Overview

We aim to upskill young Sudanese men and women with modern Digital, Agile, Customer Experience and Interpersonal skills so they can enhance their career paths, improve the business and government ways of working, improve professionalism and encourage creative ideas and team collaboration.

Cohort #1

The first cohort (group) will be 40-50 candidates. Graduates will receive the international Scrum Master certification CSM from Scrum Alliance.

Program Summary

- This program is at no cost for participants. Candidates will be vetted and tested before approving enrollment.
- Program is 10 weeks duration, 2 weeks upfront prep plus 2 weeks for each module
- Each week there is a commitment to 3 days of coursework (5-6 hrs per day)
- Courses are facilitated in-person with a live instructor with some sessions on Zoom.
- Language used is a mix of English and Arabic with translation for guest speakers
- 3 Real world project challenges, selected by prospective employers, will be used throughout the bootcamp.
- The demo day allows job sponsors to see the final work produced by the participants

Interpersonal & Soft Skills

Jan 3rd - 15th

We kickoff the bootcamp with 2 weeks focused on building foundational soft skills. This might be the most important module of all!

Customer Experience

Jan 16th - 27th

Second module is where we assign a real project to each team. We then explore the customer experience and journey, identify gaps and brainstorm better solutions.

Modules 3 & 4 > Feb 2022



Digital & Tech Skills

Jan 30th - Feb 10th

Third module builds foundation skills for using digital tools, document processing, internet and data privacy and turning basic manual processes to digital.

Agile Teamwork

Feb 13th - Feb 27th

The last module is where the team learns and applies Agile for their project, implements the solutions in a hackathon and presents it in a demo day (March 3rd) to sponsors!



1. What are the qualifications for candidates?
 - a. Age will be between 25-35 years with a few exceptions. Completed a bachelor's degree, pass the english and psychometric test and group interview. Have passion for learning, access to internet and time commitment to the full program.
2. What is the role of financial sponsors?
 - a. Financial sponsors to pay for the program costs since it's free for the participants. We aim to offer this every few months targeting 500 - 1000 in 2022. If job creation and digital skill development for youth fits your CSR goals then please contact us!
3. What is the role of job sponsors?
 - a. Job sponsors will hire new candidates from this program, give them good paying jobs, attend the demo day and engage in the program. Employers are also asked to financially support the program.

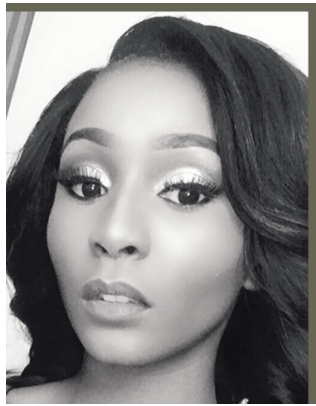
