We present the proposal to make the following interventions: -

- 1- Sheltering children with cancer in the state of Gezira, rest houses (Khartoum and Medani) by providing shelter/feeding/treatment
- 2- Secondly, intervention with dry food baskets for families (1000) families
- 3- Third, the intervention is to feed the people in camps that were impacted by the war (2 camps). The first camp has 250 people

The second camp has 70 people (Hantub)

#### Cancer Children:

Cost to cover expenses for children with cancer\*

The estimated cost is \$51,000

The time period is for 5 months

What is the intervention:

1/ Providing a follow-up service and medical interviews for sick children at Al-Zorra Madani Hospital after Burj Al-Amal Hospital in Khartoum was out of service.

2/ Providing rations + medical nutrition + the cost of travel and deportation of children from a civil governor + accommodation and subsistence of the follow-up medical staff + treatments and medicines

#### **Dry Baskets for Poor Families:**

Cost of dry baskets for affected families\*

Estimated cost \$150,000

The target number is 5000 families in Khartoum State

The cost of one food basket is \$30

\*Estimate sufficiency per basket\*

An emergency basket for food shortages, sufficient for 10 days, for the average family, numbering 5 members

Cart contents:

Flour + sugar + powdered milk + oil + pasta + noodles + sauce + tea + soap

3/ The cost of the basket can be sent to a number of beneficiary families if it is not possible to reach them because of the war or the insecurity of the road and access

#### **War Displaced Camps:**

Cost of feeding displacement camps\*

Estimated cost (\$45,000)

The time period is for 3 months

The target number of IDPs is 320 IDPs in separate small camps in Al-Jazeera state. We are currently working on feeding more than 1,000 displaced people in camps in Gezira and White Nile states

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\$140,000 has already been pledged from governments and other funders. Your \$250,000 investment will complete the funding we need to fully implement this project.
